The uploaded photo will be having a validity of ten years from the date of photograph taken.

"If a Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, Admission Ticket for eligible candidates will be made available in their Profile for One Time Registration and the date of downloading will be included in the Examination Calendar. Candidates can download Admission Ticket for 15 days from this date. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination.

- (i) The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in pursuance of this Notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of One year and a maximum period of three years provided that the list will not continue to be in force if a new Ranked List after the minimum period of expiry of one year is published. Candidates will be advised against the vacancies reported for the above post during the period of currency of the Ranked List having the scale of pay as prescribed by the concerned Company / Corporation / Board from this Ranked List, strictly in accordance with the order of receipt of vacancies in the Office of the Commission and in accordance with the rules of reservation and rotation followed by the Commission. Candidates will not have the right to choose a particular Company / Corporation / Board or scale of pay.
- (ii) The Kerala Public Service Commission shall have the power to cancel the advice for appointment of any candidate to the above post, if it is subsequently found that such advice was made under some mistake. On such cancellation the appointing authority shall

terminate the service of candidate, provided that, the cancellation of advice for appointment by the Commission and subsequent termination of service of the candidate by the appointing authority shall be made within the period of probation or 240 days from the date of joining duty whichever is earlier.

Note:- The provisional hands working in any of the above concern will be given age relaxation to the extent of their provisional service put in subject to a maximum of Five years from the upper age limit provided they were within the prescribed age limit on the date of their first appointment in the respective concern. But the regular employees of the concern are not eligible for the above concession for further appointment. The provisional hands should obtain a certificate showing the period of their provisional service in the concern and shall produce the same as and when required by the Commission. It would also be clearly specified in the certificate that they were not working in the regular service of the concern. The over aged candidates who become eligible to be included in the Ranked List on the basis of their Provisional Service in any Company / Corporation / Board will be considered only in the vacancies reported by the same Company / Corporation / Board in which they have worked provisionally.

Note	 Driving Licence shall be valid not only at the time of application but also at each stage of selection. Proficiency in driving Heavy duty vehicles is to be proved by a practical test conducted by the KPSC during the course of selection. Medical fitness shall be proved by a proper Medical Certificate obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon and Medical Certificate regarding vision from an Ophthalmologist in Government Service in the prescribed format, which must be produced as and when called for by the Commission. Physically Handicapped persons are not eligible to apply for the post. Persons appointed to the above post are required to perform the duties of Office Attendant also. However the current scale of pay and other allowances will remain the same.
