5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (From candidates belonging to Muslim community only)

6. Age limit : 22 – 39 only candidates born between 02.01.1979 and

01.01.1996 (both dates are included) are only eligible to

apply for the post.

7. Qualifications:- I or II class Masters Degree in Dance (Kerala Natanam) or its equivalent from any statutory university/ "University and Deemed Universities recognized by the UGC".

Note:-

- 1) Rule 10(a) ii of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.
- 2) Candidates who are Ph.D holders require only 50% marks for the Masters' Degree if they have acquired it prior to 19th September, 1991.
- 3) For the post of Lecturer, when qualifications are equal, preference shall be

given to those who have studied Malayalam as one of the languages either at Degree level or Post Graduate Level.
