SPECIAL RECRUITMENT - DISTRICT WISE

Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION'. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. Name of Department : Education
2. Name of Post : L.P School Assistant (Malayalam Medium)
(SR for ST only)
3. Scale of Pay :6680-10790(PR)
4. No. of vacancy : Districtwise – Wayanad -1 (One)

Note: 1) The above vacancy is now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancy and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled Tribe only during the pendency of the list.

2) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O(MS)No.154/71/PD dated: 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one district from the Ranked List so prepared is not eligible for transfer to another District unless he/she completes five (5) years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five (5) years from the commencement of service it will be subject to the orders contained in G.O(MS)No.4/61/PD dated: 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding the post in one district are restricted from applying for the same post in another district. But they can apply for the higher posts.

5. Method of appointment: Direct Recruitment (Special Recruitment from among

Scheduled Tribes only)

Note: Applications received from candidates other than Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6. Age : 18- 45
Only Candidates born between 02.01.1969 and 01.01.1996
(both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. No other age relaxation will be allowed.

Note: In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7. Qualifications: (1) A pass in SSLC Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala or its equivalent

OR

A pass in Pre-Degree Examination conducted by any of the Universities in Kerala or any Examination recognised by any such Universities as equivalent to the Pre-degree Examinations

OR

A pass in Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or any other examination recognised by Government as equivalent thereto

AND

2) A pass in T.T.C Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala

Special Note: 1) B.Ed Degree is not acceptable as an alternative qualification for T.T.C

2) Candidates who have not studied the Regional Language Malayalam either under Part I or Part II or as a medium of instruction of S.S.L.C will not be eligible for appointment to the post. G.O(Rt)No.534/02/G.Edn dated:19.03.2002 and G.O(MS)No.44/75/G.Edn dated: 29.01.1975.

3) Question Paper for Written Test if any will be in Malayalam , the candidates should answer the questions in Malayalam

4) Those who have no training qualification can also apply if selected in the absence of candidates with training qualification they will have to acquire

training qualification within three (3) years from the date of appointment (G.O(MS)63/82/Edn dated: 03.05.1982)

Special Concession: 1) Preference will be given as laid down in G.O(MS)No.50/70/PD dated: 12.02.1970 and G.O(MS)No.9/78/Gen.Edn dated: 21.01.1978 to wives of Jawans in the matter of Special Recruitment as teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualifications

Wives of Jawans should produce proper certificate from the officer commanding stating the name, military rank and military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission.

Soldiers in active service and those working in the Base Establishments are included under the term of 'Jawans'. G.O(MS)No.509/64/Edn dated:19.09.1964, G.O(MS)No.614/65/Edn dated:19.11.1965 and G.O(MS) No.243/66/Edn dated:27.05.1966.

2) First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers as per G.O(MS)No.122/75/G.Edn dated:27.05.1975

8. Method of submitting applications:

Before applying for the post, candidates should register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' Scheme on the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in . Those who have already registered can apply by logging on to their profile using his/her User-id and password. Candidates shall click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective post in the Notification link for applying for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view, rectify defects and have a print out of the details in the profile if required by clicking on the link Registration Card. Candidates are responsible to ensure the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of their password and they shall keep in mind the user id for further communication with the commission. Before applying for a post candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-id for further communication with the commission. Applications once submitted will be received as provisional and particulars shall not be deleted or altered after submission . Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the conditions given in the notification will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove qualification, age, community etc have to be produced as and when called for.

9. Last date for receipt of applications: 16.04.2014 Wednesday upto 12 midnight

11. If a Written Test or OMR Test is conducted as part of the selection, admission tickets of eligible candidates will be made available on the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download their admission tickets as per the instructions on the website.

12. Paragraphs two, three and twenty five (except the conditions laid down in the Rule 3 (C) of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules) are not applicable to this selection.

13. Appointments are made on the basis of the rank secured in the Ranked List of candidates prepared in pursuance of this notification subject to the conditions laid down in G.O.(P) No. 21/76/PD dated, 17.01.1976 and G.O. (P) No. 25/94/GAD dated, 22.01.1994 allowing special reservations to Scheduled Tribes in accordance with the procedures made for this purpose from time to time and subject to the rules under sections 3 (c) 17 (a), 17(b) of Part II of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958.
