THIRD NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION'. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. **Department** : Vocational Higher Secondary Education
2. **Name of post** : Vocational Teacher in Cosmetology and Beauty Parlour Management
3. **Scale of pay** : 19240 – 34500
4. **Number of vacancy** : Scheduled Caste-1 (One)

The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the above vacancy earmarked for Scheduled Castes, but remains unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the ranked list published on 14.01.2008 as category No.163/2004.

5. **Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment from Scheduled Caste candidates only. But applications of Scheduled Tribe candidates will also be considered in the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates.

Note :- Applications of candidates belonging to castes or communities other than Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them.

6. **Age limit** : 23-45. Only candidates born between 02.01.1969 and 01.01.1991(both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. [For conditions regarding the age relaxation, please see Para 2 of the General Conditions except para 2 (i)]
7. **Qualifications** : Post Graduate Degree in any branch with not less than 50% marks awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or an equivalent qualification with a certificate (minimum 1 year duration) in Cosmetology and Beauty Parlour Management from a Government recognised Institution.

Note : In the appointment of Vocational Teachers, preference will be given to persons having additional qualification of Diploma in Computer Application from a recognised Institution.

2. All the educational qualifications for teaching posts should be one acquired after a regular course of study from a recognised University in Kerala or recognised as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.

Note : Rule 10 (a) ii of part II of KS&SSR is applicable.

8. Method of submitting Applications :-

Before applying for the post, candidates shall register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' scheme through the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in'. Those who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using his/her User-ID and Password. No application fee is required. Candidates can view, rectify defects and print the details in the registration card by clicking the link Registration card after entering the home page. Candidates are responsible to ensure correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password and they shall keep in mind the User ID for further communication with the Commission. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, community age etc have to be produced as and when called for.
