6. Age Limit: 20 - 41

Only candidates born between 02.01.1972 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Communities. 7. Qualifications

1. MBA with Computer Application as an optional paper with not less than 60% marks in aggregate from a University recognised by any University in Kerala after undergoing a regular course of study.

OR

MCA Degree with not less than 60% marks in aggregate from a recognised University after undergoing a regular course of study and Post Graduate Diploma in Business Management from a Government Recognised institution.

OR

B.Tech. Degree with not less than 60% marks in Computer Science with a Post Graduate Diploma in Business Management from a Government recognised institution after undergoing a regular course of study.

2. Eight years experience in teaching/Industry after acquiring the qualification out of which three years shall be at the level of Lecturer in Polytechnics.
