FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION'. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. Department : Health Services
2. Name of post : Treatment Organizer Gr.II
3. Scale of pay : ₹ 9940 – 16580.
4. No. of vacancies : Districtwise
Palakkad – Scheduled Caste – 1 (One)

Note:-

- (i) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the Community other than those notified will summarily be rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates. In the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates Scheduled Tribe candidates will also be considered.
- (ii) A ranked list will be prepared for Palakkad district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following dates in the following districts.

- (iii) The candidates shall submit application for the post to Palakkad district where the vacancy is in existence for their community and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column of the online application.
- (iv) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO (MS) No. 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in the revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS) No.4/61/PD, dated 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding the same post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to SC community only). (In the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates belongs to Scheduled Tribe will also be considered).
6. Age limit : 18- 41. Only candidates born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1996 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post including the relaxation as per para 2(i) of General Conditions.

Note :- For conditions regarding other age relaxation, please see para 2 of General Conditions except Para 2 (i).

7. **Qualifications:**

- 1 General: A Pass in Pre Degree or Higher Secondary Course (+2).
2. Technical :- A pass in T.B. Health Visitors Course conducted by the T.B. Association of India, New Delhi or any other equivalent qualification recognised by Government of Kerala.

Note:- 1. In the absence of persons with technical qualification those with HSS Certificates in science subjects will be selected and they will be given 6 months training in the State T.B Centre, Thiruvananthapuram. The period of training will not count for probation or increment but such candidates will have to execute a bond to serve the department for 10 years as Treatment Organiser for tuberculosis programme and stipend for 6 months i.e Rs 2480/-. The amount of bonded obligation is Rs 2480 together with sum of Rs 1240 as liquidated damages.

2. Probation. Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he/she joins duty be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

8. Mode of submitting Applications:

Candidates must register as per “ ONE TIME REGISTRATION” on the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' . Those who have already registered shall apply by logging on to their profile using their user ID and password. Candidates must click on the `Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a printout of the details in the profile by clicking the link **Registration Card**. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before applying for a post, candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile and they shall quote the User Id for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted will be received as provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Applications submitted not in accordance with the conditions of the notification will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove qualification has to be produced as and when called for.

9. Last date of receipt of applications: **15.10.2014** Wednesday up to 12 midnight.
