Candidates will be advised for appointment against aforesaid vacancy and also against the vacancies if any reported during the currency of the list.
- (ii) Applications shall be submitted to Palakkad district only where the vacancy exists in response to this notification and candidates should note the name of the District against the relevant column of the online application.
- (iii) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O. (Ms)No.154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O(MS)No.4/61/PD, dated 02.1.1961.
