FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION'. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

- 1 **Department** : Agriculture
- 2 **Name of Post** : Tractor Driver
- 3 **Scale of Pay** : Rs.9190 - 15780/-
- 4 **Number of vacancies** : *Ezhava/Thiyya/Billava - Kollam-1 (one)*

NOTE:

(i) Conventional type applications will be summarily rejected. Candidates shall apply only through online application facility under one time registration scheme available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website viz. www.keralapsc.gov.in.

(ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be issued to these candidates.

(iii) Separate ranked list will be prepared for above district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post on 3.12.12 in Kollam District as Category No. 200/07.

(iv) The candidates shall submit application for the post to the district concerned where the vacancy is in existence for their respective community and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column in the online application. Applications should not be sent to more than one district in response to this notification. If applications are submitted contrary to the above direction and if he/she is selected, his/her name will be removed from the Ranked List and disciplinary action will taken against him/her.

(v) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O. (Ms) No 154/71/PD dated, 27-05-1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from

the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes 5 years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O. (MS) No. 4/61/PD. dated, 02.01.1961. Candidates

already in Government Service holding the same post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5 Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to reservation group of Community, Ezhava/ Thiyya/ Billava only)

6 Age Limit : Ezhava/Thiyya/Billava 19-39, only candidates born between 02.01.1974 and 01.01.1994 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

(This includes the relaxation as per para 2(i) of General Conditions)

Note: - For concessions allowed in Upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para (2) of the General Conditions under part II of this notification except para2(i).

7. Qualifications:-

(1) Diploma in Agricultural and Rural Engineering awarded by the Kerala Agricultural University.

In the absence of persons with the qualifications prescribed under item I above the persons with the following qualifications will be considered.

i) National Trade Certificate in any of the following trades from the I.T.I.

(a) Mechanic (Tractor)

(b) Mechanic (Motor vehicle)

(c) Mechanic (Diesel)

(d) Fitter

ii) Practical experience of not less than one year in the trade. The Practical experience should be one acquired after the acquisition of I.T.I. Trade certificate.

(2) The candidates should possess a valid Tractor Driving licence.

Note:-(i) Candidates shall possess a current Driving licence throughout all the stages of selection process as on the last date of application, OMR test, practical test, interview etc.

(ii) Proficiency in the field of work will be assessed in a practical test conducted by the Public Service Commission.

10. Mode of submitting application:

Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' System on the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in'. Candidates can view, rectify defect and have a print-out of the details on the Registration Card by clicking the link the registration card after entering the home page. Before applying for a post, candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile and they shall keep in mind the User Id for further communication with the Commission. Applications once submitted will be received as provisional and particulars shall not be deleted or altered after submission. Applications which once submitted not in accordance with the conditions of the notification will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
