- (iii) Separate Ranked List will be prepared for above districts in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above communities, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following districts or 3 years from the date of publication of this NCA ranked list whichever is earlier.

- (iv) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(MS) No.154/71/PD dated, 27/05/1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district, Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O.(MS)No.36/91/P&ARD dated 02/12/1991. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.
- (v) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to those candidates. Application should not be submitted to more than one district in response to this notification. If applications are sent contrary to the above direction and if the candidate is selected his/her name will be removed from the Ranked List and disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.
- (vi) If the community claim in the application differs from the community noted in S.S.L.C., then such changes are to be published in the Gazette and the same should be produced along with the Community Certificate/Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities at the time of One Time Verification or as and when required by the Commission.

6. Age Limit

: Direct Recruitment (From Ex-servicemen candidates belonging to above reservation communities only).

- 1. 18-39, Only candidates born between 02.01.1983 and 01.01.2004 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post in the case of Muslim, Dheevara, SIUC Nadar, Hindu Nadar, OBC and SCCC communities[including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General Conditions].
- 2. 18-41, Candidates born between 02.01.1981 and 01.01.2004 (both dates are included) are eligible to apply for this post in the case of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Communities [including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General Conditions].

Note:In the case of adult members belonging to Scheduled castes and their children who had converted to Christianity after becoming a major, the upper age limit shall be 41 years ie;Candidates born between 02.01.1981 and 01.01.2004

Note:- 1) For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years of age, please see para 2 of general condition under Part II of this notification.

## 7. Qualifications:-

- (i) Should have passed standard VII and should not have acquired any Graduation.
- (ii) Should be an Ex-servicemen

Note: i)Rule 10 (a)(ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.

ii)Service in Border Security Force (BSF),Defence Security Corps(DSC),Assam Rifles,General Reserve Engineering Force(GREF),Jammu and Kashmir Militia and Lok Sahayak Sewa will not be treated as Military Service as shown in G.O(P)no.399/77 /GAD dated 26.11.1977.

iii)Those who claim equivalent qualification shall produce the respective Government Order to prove the claim at the time of One Time Verification or as required by the Commission.

## 8. Mode of Sending applications:-

Candidates must register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and Password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2012. The candidates creating new profile should upload the photograph taken within six months. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for Candidates who have AADHAAR Card should add AADHAAR Card as ID Proof in their profile.

The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calender itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phones registered in it. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination. As per Rule22 of the KPSC Rules of Procedure appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against those candidates who submit application for the post with false claims of possession of prescribed qualification, experience etc. and give confirmation for examination, irrespective of the fact that they have appeared or not for the examination.
