FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited online only from qualified candidates of Ex-servicemen belonging to following reservation community of Kerala State only for appointment in the under mentioned post. Application must be submitted online through the Official website of the Kerala Public Service Commission after 'One Time Registration'. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. Department : **NCC/Sainik Welfare**
2. Name of post : **Last Grade Servants (Ex-servicemen only)**
3. Scale of pay : **₹ 23000-50200 /-**
4. Number of vacancies : **District wise**

Note:

- (i) This is the first NCA notification for the post for Malappuram district due to non availability of SC candidates in the Ranked List notified vide Cat.No. 385/2017 in the gazette dated 12.10.2017.
- (ii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be subject to the rules amended as per G.O(P)No.12/2016/P&ARD dated 04.06.2016.
- (iii) A Ranked List will be prepared for the above district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the above identified vacancy earmarked for the above community, and remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates for selection till date from the ranked list published for the post.

- (iv) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(MS) No.154/71/PD dated, 27/05/1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O.(P)No.36/91/P&ARD dated 02/12/1991. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.
- (v) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the community other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to those candidates.

5. Method of appointment : **Direct Recruitment (From Ex-servicemen candidates belonging to**

Scheduled Caste community only).

6. Age Limit : 18-44, Candidates born between 02.01.1979 and 01.01.2005 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post [including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General Conditions].

Note:- For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years of age, please see para 2 of general condition under Part II of this notification.

7. Qualifications:-

- (i) Should have passed standard VII and should not have acquired any Graduation.
- (ii) Should be an Ex-serviceman

Note: i) Rule 10 (a)(ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.

ii) Service in Border Security Force (BSF), Defence Security Corps (DSC), Assam Rifles, General Reserve Engineering Force (GREF), Jammu and Kashmir Militia and Lok Sahayak Sewa will not be treated as Military Service as shown in G.O(P)No.399/77 /GAD dated 26.11.1977.

iii) Candidates possessing Military Graduation Certificate are eligible to apply for this post as per G.O(P)No.5/2018/P&ARD dated 19.04.2018.

iv) The following personnel who have served in the Territorial Army will be considered as Ex-serviceman.

- a) Personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spell of qualifying service.
- b) Gallantry award winners of the Armed forces including personnel of Territorial Army.
- c) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.

Those who produce an authentic document proving that they belong to anyone of the above three categories will be considered for selection.

v) In addition to the qualifications prescribed in the notification, the qualifications recognized by executive orders or standing orders of Government as equivalent to a qualification specified for a post, in the Special Rules and such of those qualifications which pre-suppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post, shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of the Government Orders declaring equivalent/higher qualifications shall be produced as and when required by the Commission.

Probation:- Every person appointed to a category shall be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of three years.

8. Mode of Sending applications :-

Candidates must register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and Password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2013. Candidates creating new profile on or after 01.01.2022 shall upload photograph taken within six months. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. **Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the**

application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Candidates who have AADHAAR Card should add AADHAAR Card as ID Proof in their profile.

9. Last date for receipt of applications : **03.01.2024** Wednesday upto 12:00 Midnight
10. Address to which applications are to be submitted : www.keralapsc.gov.in
11. If a Written Test/OMR/Online Examination is conducted as a part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their 'One Time Registration' profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calender itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phones registered in it. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination. As per Rule 22 of the KPSC Rules of Procedure, 1976 appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against those candidates who submit application for the post with false claims of possession of prescribed qualification, experience etc. and give confirmation for examination, irrespective of the fact that they have appeared or not for the examination.

12 Special Instructions to Candidates

1. In the case of difference in Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a gazette notification in this regard, along with Community certificate at the time of certificate verification.

2. Candidates are required to acquaint themselves with the instructions given in the notification as Part II, General Conditions before submitting application for the post. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions laid down in the General Conditions are liable to be rejected.

3. Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rule 22 of the Kerala Public Service Commission Rules of Procedure 1976 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and are liable to be disqualified for being considered for a particular post or debarment from applying to the Commission either permanently or for any period or the invalidation of their answer scripts or products in the written/practical test or the initiation of criminal or other proceedings against them or their removal or dismissal from office or the ordering of any other disciplinary action against them if they have already been appointed, or any one or more of the above.
