Application must be submitted online through the Official website of the Commission after One Time Registration at the Commission web site www.keralapsc.gov.in. . The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made for the above mentioned battalion. Candidates appointed to the Battalion will be allowed transfer only to the concerned District Armed Reserves as shown above.

Note:-

- (i) Applications for the post shall be submitted in online mode only and applications submitted otherwise will be summarily rejected.
- (ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.
- (iii) Ranked Lists will be prepared for the Battalion in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until the commencement of the training of the candidates advised against all the NCA Turns identified for the above communities for the Battalion during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post as per Category No 250/2011 Notification for the above Battalion.

5. Method of appointment :- Direct Recruitment from candidates belonging to the above mentioned community only (Battalion wise)
6. Age Limit : 18-29. Candidates born between 02.01.1986 and 01.01.1997 are eligible to apply for this post (both dates included) and candidates who have converted to Christianity from SC

community after attaining 18 years and children of such parents born between 2.1.1984 and 1.1.1997 are eligible to apply for this post (age relaxation as per General conditions 2 (i) of Part II of Gazette).

Note :-Women candidates and differently abled persons are not eligible to apply in response to this notification.

7. Qualifications :-

(a) Educational: Pass in HSE (plus 2) or its equivalent.

KS & SSR Part II Rule 10 (a) ii is applicable.

(b) Physical Qualifications:

(i) Height : A minimum of 168 cm.

(ii) Chest : 81 cm with a minimum expansion of 5 cm.

(iii) Eye Sight : Must be certified to possess the visual standards specified below without glasses.

<u>Vision</u>	<u>Right Eye</u>	<u>Left Eye</u>
a. Distant Vision	6/6 Snellen	6/6 Snellen
b. Near Vision	0.5 Snellen	0.5 Snellen

Note:-

(i) Each eye must have a full field of vision. Colour blindness, squint or any morbid conditions of the Eye or lids of either eye will be deemed to be a disqualification.

(ii) Must be free from apparent physical defects like Knock-knee, Flat Foot, Varicose vein, Bow legs, Deformed limbs, irregular and protruding tooth, Defective speech and hearing.

(c) Must qualify in any five events out of eight events specified below of the National Physical Efficiency, One Star Standard Test.

Note:- The Physical measurement of candidates will be taken at the time of physical efficiency test and those who do not possess the prescribed Physical Measurement will not be admitted for the physical efficiency test. If accidents or injuries happen to a candidate while participating in the physical efficiency test, he will not be given further chance to participate in the test.

The candidate should upload in their profile, a Medical Certificate in the form prescribed hereunder certifying to their physical fitness and eyesight without glasses, at the time of certificate verification. The Medical Certificate should be one obtained from a Medical officer under the Government not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon.

Note: Details regarding standards of vision should be clearly stated in the Certificate as given above and vague statement such as Vision `Normal' etc will not be accepted. Specification for each eye should be stated separately. If the specification are not as indicated above, the officers issuing the Certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standards of vision as the case may be, otherwise the Certificate will not be accepted.

- 9. Mode of submitting Applications :-

Candidates must register as per “ ONE TIME REGISTRATION” with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the `Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to applying for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be

printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote their User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The Application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

If Written Test/OMR Test is conducted as a part of the selection Admission Tickets of eligible candidates will be made available in the profile of the candidates, created as part of one time registration at the website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download and print their Admission tickets as per the instructions given in the website.
