Training:- Every candidate selected for appointment as Dairy Farm Instructor shall undergo eight months training before they are appointed regularly. The training shall be imparted by the Dairy Development Department. They shall be paid the minimum of the basic pay of Dairy Farm Instructor per mensem as consolidated allowance during the period of training . The period of training shall not be counted for probation and increment.

Probation:- Every Person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

8. Mode of submitting applications :-

Candidates shall register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION ' system on the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' for applying for the post. Candidates who have registered shall apply by logging in to their profile using their User- ID and password. Candidates shall click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification link for applying for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall valid for 10 years from the date of uploading, There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a print-out of the details in the profile by clicking the link Registration Card, if required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before applying for a post, candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Applications once submitted will be received as provisional and particulars shall not be deleted or altered after submission. Applications submitted not in accordance with the conditions of the notification will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. The profile correction made by the candidate or in the office of KPSC on request after the last date fixed for receipt of application will not reflect in the application, Such corrections will be in effect on the date on which corrections have been made

Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR card as I.D Proof in their profile.

If Written test / OMR Test is conducted as a part of the selection, Admission Tickets of eligible candidates will be made available in the profile for one time registration and the date of downloading will be included in the Examination calendar. Candidate can download admission tickets for 15 days from this date . Candidates who have downloaded the admission tickets will alone be permitted to attend the examination
