- **5. Method of appointment**: **Direct Recruitment** (from Scheduled Caste candidates only.)
 - Note: 1. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe will be considered for appointment in the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates.
 - 2. Application submitted by candidates other than those belonging to SC&ST will be rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to them individually.

6. Age Limit: 25-41

Only candidates born between 02.01.1976 and 01.01.1992 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (inclusive of relaxation in Para 2 (1) of the General Conditions).

7. Qualifications: -

First Class or Second class Master's Degree in History of Arts with not less than 55% marks obtained from a recognised university.

Note: Rule 10 (a) (ii) of Part II KS&SSR is applicable.
