Candidates selected under this category should be in service of the Member Society not only on the date of application but also on the date of appointment.
- (2) Graduation from a recognized university with not less than 50% of marks in aggregate, and Higher Diploma in Co-operation (HDC or HDC & BM of the State Co-operative Union of Kerala *OR* HDC and HDCM of National Council for Co-operative Training or successful completion of the Subordiate (Junior) Personal Co-operative Training Course (Junior) Diploma in Co-operation.

Bsc (Co-operation with Banking) of Kerala Agricultural University.

OR

B.Com (with Co-operation) recognized by any of the Universities in Kerala with not less than 50% marks in the aggregate.

(3) MBA/CA/CWA/M.Com/M.Sc (Co-operation and Banking) of Kerala Agricultural University will be preferential qualification.
